Dear Morissan,

We have received feedback from the publisher. Your paper-**The Influence of Anti-smoking Campaign on Willingness to Quit Smoking Among University Students** has a 44% similarity index . This is high. Therefore, you are required to revise the paper in order to reduce the similarity index.

Below is the detail explanation from the publisher.

The maximum percentage of similarity rate should be no more than 10% in total. While checking manuscripts, we exclude Quotes and Bibliography and omit similarities up to 10% (from 1 source). This means, up to 10% of plagiarism can be considered accidental or unintentional for the whole paper.

If the similarity percentage is more than %10 from one source, we would recommend you to use block quotation. In such a case, direct quotation will not be considered as plagiarism even though the similarity percentage is more than %10.

1. How can be cited direct quotations?

When quoting, it is necessary to maintain Author, year and specific page citation or paragraph number for reference.

- If the quotation is less than 40 words incorporate it into the text and enclose the quotation with quotation marks. Cite the source immediately after the close of the quotation marks.

Examples:

- o If the authors are named in the text, they do not have to be used in the citation.

"A neurosis is characterized by anxiety," according to Kristen and Warb's (2012, p. 157) longitudinal study.

- o If the authors are not named in the text, the correct format should be like below.

In fact, "a neurosis is characterized by anxiety" (Kristen & Warb, 2012, p. 157).

- If the quotation has more than 40 words, use a block quotation.

- Begin the quotation on a new line and indent a half-inch from the left margin.
- Do not add quotation marks
- Double-space the entire quotation
- At the end of the quote put the period after the last word of the sentence followed by the parentheses

Example:

Colvin (2010) explored every angle of talent concept as follows:

People often use it just to mean excellent performance or to describe those who are terrific performers. "The Red Sox have a lot of talent in the outfield" means only that the outfielders are very good. "The war for talent," a popular topic in business and the title of a book, means the fight to attract good performers. In the TV business, "talent" is the generic term for anyone who appears on camera. "Get the talent on set!" just means get the performers to their places; anyone who watches much TV realizes that in this case the term is totally nonjudgmental. None of those meanings is the critical one. When the term is used in ways that change the courses of people's lives, it has a specific meaning (p.20-21).
